

# Stages of expanding the center

- 1**  
**A** New Dhamma hall is built with a capacity of 150 persons. Special considerations are made to have a spacious hall with a high ceiling and generous space between the meditators.
- B** Present Dhamma hall 1 becomes accommodation for approximately an additional 20 students, until new accommodations in the forest are built.
- More beds are added to male and female houses. Students start to eat in shifts, since the dining halls are not big enough for all to eat at the same time.
- 1-2** In step 1 or 2: New long-term server accommodation is built in the forest on the south part of center land.
- 2** New male and female accommodations are built as single rooms with attached bathrooms. One public bathroom is built on the short side of each house.
- 3**  
**A** A new building is built replacing the present building of Dhamma hall 1. The new building is to contain the male dining hall, new kitchen, and office. With bigger male and female dining halls, students no longer has to eat in shifts.
- The upper floor of main building, that previously housed male dining hall and kitchen is converted to residence for assistant teachers and interview room.
- B** The new building in 3A makes it possible for the present assistant teacher/office house to be rebuilt to accommodation for male servers.
- 4** New server house is built in the forest south of female house, replacing the aging present server house. This new server house accommodates female serves.
- 5** A new building is built for meditation cells. Either as a standalone building in the forest behind the new Dhamma hall, or as an extension of the new Dhamma hall building.
